Black Holes: The Dark Centres of Universe

The history of black holes is not too old. It all started when Einstein was working on his theory of General Relativity. According to which, gravitational pull not only affects the massive objects but light and even time are also get affected by it which can force the light to deviate from its straight path and can cause kinematical time dilation.

In 19th century, with the works of great physicists Subrahmanyan Chandrasekhar and Karl Schwarzschild, the existence of black holes got realistically proven.

Black holes are created in our universe when a very massive star dies and it gets contracted into a finite volume due to its strong gravitational pull. The gravitational pull is so strong that even light is not able to escape from it. Some common examples of black holes are Stellar black holes and Primordial black holes. At the centre of our Milky Way galaxy, there is a black hole named as Sagittarius A.

The latest photograph of a black hole was taken in 2019 by Event horizon telescope, which is very helpful in explaining the anatomy of a black hole. Outside a black hole, first of all there is one Accretion layer, which is created by fast moving particles attracted by this black hole and due to their high speed, EM radiations are produced. It is circular in shape. Moving further, there is a region called Event Horizon or No Return point, as light is not able to escape from this region. At last, the centre of black hole is called Singularity because at this site, gravity becomes infinite and if anything falls in it, it will not be able to return.

In the end I can say, this is the just beginning and a lot of curiosity and excitement is left in this field. We all can expect, in nearby future, number of facts will be revealed about black holes, which inspire our students to become research scholars and scientists.

Importance of Lohri

Lohri is celebrated at the end of the traditional month when the winter solstice occurs. It celebrates the days getting longer as the sun proceeds on its northward journey. The day after Lohri is celebrated as Maghi Sangrand. Lohri also marks the very famous story of Dullah Bhatti of Punjab.

Basically, the belief goes that this is where this started being celebrated as a festival. According to legends, the origin of Lohri is related to Dullah Bhatti, who is popularly known as "Robin Hood of Punjab". He was the greatest muslim robber of Punjab during the period of Mughal rule (Akbar and his son Jahangir). He led a rebellion against the famous Mughal king Akbar and was successful as well.

Dullah Bhatti was born in a Punjabi family to mother Lodhi and father Farid Khan in the area of Sandan Baar, near Faisalabad (now in Pakistan) (Sandal Baar is also related to the legend of Mirza Sahiba). He belonged to the warrior like Rajput class of Bhattis. He follows the footsteps of his father and grandfather refused to accept the legitimacy of Mughal King Akbar and put up by the rebels that Akbar had to shift his imperial capital to Lahore for nearly 20 years. When Akbar came to Lahore, he ordered the execution of the rebels. Legend has it that to instill fear into the hearts of the common man, Akbar got their skins stuffed with wheat hay (tool) and hung the dead bodies on the main door.

He robbed from the rich and distributed it among the poor. He also rescued many Hindi Punjabi girls were being taken forcefully to be sold in the slave market. Then, he used to arrange a marriage for them according to Hindu rituals and provided them dowries. After his public execution in Lahore, In the memory of their savior, the girls sang songs and danced around the bonfire. This became a tradition of Punjab from that day and was celebrated gracefully all over Punjab annually as Lohri. So in every Lohri songs there are words to express gratitude to Dullah Bhatti.

The Story of Great Saviour 'Dullah Bhatti'

The festival of Lohri is celebrated in praise of Dullah Bhatti. Most songs of Lohri glorify him and are sung in his remembrance. The story goes like this...

Once there lived a very beautiful young girl in a village of Punjab. The girl belonged to a very poor family. One day the feudal lords of the region abducted the girl. They dishonored and disgraced her and took her for selling in the slave market. Soon the word about her abduction spread around the village. In the village there lived a highway robber named Abdullah Bhatti.

When he came to know about it he attacked the federal lords and rescued the girl. He took her to his hideout in the old fort. He adopted the girl as his daughter and married her to a young and modest Hindu boy before a bonfire [according to Hindu wedding tradition]. He gave a kilo of sugar to the girl as her wedding gift. [This incident took place in the season of sugar harvest]. Bhatti became popular as Dullah Bhatti [the word Dullah means bridegroom) for his noble work. People loved and respected him. He is still remembered and the songs of Lohri include his name.
