





# Lata Mangeshkar



A legend of music world with immense popularity bade good bye to us physically by leaving an imprint in the world for many generations to come. Such is the magic of music which influenced, enthralled and inspired the people.

Like Elvis Pressley of USA who became the cultural icon of 20<sup>th</sup> Century of America or Paul David Hewson of Ireland who enriched the European music world, Lata Mangeshkar who was called as Hema Mangeshkar in her childhood conquered the music world of Indian subcontinent.

It is a blessing that all her siblings Meena, Asha, Usha and Haridaynath are accomplished singers. Her career of singing was not an easy cake-walk. After learning classical music under Ustad Amanat Ali Khan and others she had to wait for long. In 1942 she sang her first song for a Marathi movie which was finally cut from release. Many directors had even refused her to give a chance. But, as it is a universal truth that the real talents can not be hidden or stopped, she also could prove to the world that perseverance and dedication would never become futile.

Her span from 28<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1929 to 6<sup>th</sup> Feb 2022 of 93 years, around 7 decades, she sang thousands of songs in 36 Indian and Foreign languages including 'English, French and Swahli. She is conferred with many national and international awards like Padma Vibhushan, Dada Sahib Phalke award, Bharat Ratna. She was also conferred with the highest French Cvilian Award of 'Officer of the National order of the legion of Honour' in 2007. Among the mass of Indian sub-continent she will be remembered as the 'Queen of Melody', 'Nightingale of India' and 'Voice of Millennium'.

Lata Mangeshkar through her voice integrated the diversity of India and thereby her name is written in the golden words in Indian history.

# TRUE HEROES

14<sup>th</sup> February is considered a Black Day in Indian History. Pulwama attack took place by leaving the country in shock. Pulwama attack is one of the deadliest terror attacks in Jammu and Kashmir in which 40 CRPF personnel were martyred. This terrorist attack was carried out by a suicide bomber. A convoy of vehicles carrying Indian security personnel on the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway was attacked by a vehicle – borne suicide bomber at Lethapora, Pulwama district of Jammu and Kashmir. Thus this day is considered a Black Day. The responsibility of the attack was claimed by the Pakistan based Islamic terrorist group, Jaish-e-Mohammad. India blamed Pakistan for the attack while the latter condemned the attack and denied having any connections with it. The attack gave a severe blow to India-Pakistan relations, consequently resulting in the 2019 India-Pakistan military standoff. Subsequently, Indian investigations identified 19 accused. By August 2021, the main accused along with six others had been killed and seven had been arrested. Let us bow down to the brave martyrs and recall them who lost their lives in the gruesome Pulwama attack. India will never forget the exceptional courage and the supreme sacrifice of those soldiers.

# Sarojini Naidu

Sarojini Naidu was born on 13<sup>th</sup> February 1879. Her father's name was Aghorenath Chattopadhyay. He was a teacher and her mother's name was Barada Sundari Devi and she was a poet. So the amazing quality of being a writer/poet came from her home. She joined the revolt of freedom in an early age and met Gopal Chandra Gokhale and Mahatma Gandhi. After being impressed by her poems and writings, Gandhi ji named her "Bharat ki Koyal" or "Nightingale of India."

Later, she joined, many protests and Satyagraha. After, India got independence, she was elected as the governor of Uttar Pradesh. She executed her duties brilliantly. She was first women to attend the meeting of congress after Annie Basant. She was elected as the President of Indian National Congress in 1925. She was married to G. Govindarajulu Naidu.

She died on 2 March 1947 due to cardiac arrest (heart failure). She spent major part of her life in Hyderabad.

She was a patriot who wrote mostly about India's struggle and hope of freedom. Some of her, famous writings are 'The Bangle Seller', 'The gift of India' and 'The Bazar of Hyderabad.'

She did many good deeds in her life and most of them were for the welfare of our country. She was also a good orator and was a great follower of Gandhi ji and his principles and also influenced many Indians to fight for freedom of our country. Her writings also reflected her love for India, culture of people and stages of life. Many people were influenced by her writings and loved her work. She will always remain in our heart.

ਭਗਤ ਰਵੀਦਾਸ ਜੀ ਦਾ ਜਨਮ 1450 ਈ. ਨੂੰ ਬਨਾਰਸ ਵਿਖੇ ਮਾਘ ਸੁਦੀ ਦੀ ਪੂਰਨਮਾਸੀ ਵਾਲੇ ਦਿਨ ਹੋਇਆ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦੀ ਮਾਤਾ ਜੀ ਦਾ ਨਾਂ ਕਲਸਾਂ ਦੇਵੀ ਅਤੇ ਪਿਤਾ ਜੀ ਦਾ ਨਾਂ ਸੰਤੋਖ ਦਾਸ ਸੀ।

ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦੇ ਪਿਤਾ ਜੀ ਚਮੜੇ ਦਾ ਕੰਮ ਕਰਦੇ ਸਨ। ਜਿਸ ਤੋਂ ਬਹੁਤ ਸਾਰੀਆਂ ਚੀਜ਼ਾਂ ਬਣਾਈਆਂ ਜਾਂਦੀਆਂ ਸਨ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦੇ ਜਨਮ ਸਮੇਂ ਜਾਤ-ਪਾਤ, ਉਚ-ਨੀਚ ਦਾ ਭੇਦ ਭਾਵ ਜ਼ੋਰਾਂ ਤੇ ਸੀ। ਜਾਤਾਂ ਦੇ ਆਧਾਰ ਤੇ ਵੰਡ ਕੀਤੀ ਹੋਈ ਸੀ, ਨਿਮਨ ਸ਼੍ਰੇਣੀ ਦੇ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਵੇਦ ਪਾਠ ਪੜ੍ਹਨ ਦੀ ਵੀ ਆਗਿਆ ਨਹੀਂ ਸੀ। ਸਮਾਜ ਵਿੱਚ ਔਰਤ ਦੀ ਸਥਿਤੀ ਵੀ ਕੋਈ ਬਹੁਤੀ ਚੰਗੀ ਨਹੀਂ ਸੀ। ਸਤੀ ਪ੍ਰਥਾ ਅਤੇ ਪਰਦੇ ਦੀ ਰਸਮ ਜ਼ੋਰਾਂ ਤੇ ਸੀ। ਇਹ ਵੀ ਕਿਹਾ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦਾ ਜਨਮ ਇਸ ਸਭ ਕੁਝ ਦੇ ਖਾਤਮੇ ਲਈ ਹੀ ਹੋਇਆ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਕੋਲ ਕਈ ਅਲੌਕਿਕ ਸ਼ਕਤੀਆਂ ਸਨ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਬਚਪਨ ਵਿੱਚ ਹੀ ਅਧਿਆਤਮਕ ਜਾਗ੍ਰਤੀ ਹੋ ਗਈ ਸੀ। ਇਹ ਆਪਣੀ ਅਜਿਹੀ ਸ਼ਕਤੀ ਨਾਲ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਦੇ ਰੋਗ ਵੀ ਦੂਰ ਕਰ ਦਿੰਦੇ ਸਨ। ਇਹ ਸਦਾ ਹੀ ਪ੍ਰਭੂ ਭਗਤੀ ਦੇ ਵਿੱਚ ਲੀਨ ਰਹਿੰਦੇ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੇ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਇਹ ਸੁਨੇਹਾ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਪ੍ਰਮਾਤਮਾ ਹਰ ਥਾਂ ਮੌਜੂਦ ਹੈ ਤੁਸੀਂ ਜਿੱਥੇ ਹੋ ਉੱਥੇ ਹੀ ਭਗਤੀ, ਜਾਂ ਪ੍ਰਮਾਤਮਾ ਦਾ ਨਾਂ ਲੈ ਸਕਦੇ ਹੋ।

ਭਗਤ ਰਵੀ ਦਾਸ ਜੀ ਦੀ ਬਾਣੀ ਸ੍ਰੀ ਗੁਰੂ ਗ੍ਰੰਥ ਸਾਹਿਬ ਵਿੱਚ ਵੀ ਦਰਜ ਹੈ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦੀ ਸੋਚ ਮੁਤਾਬਕ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਗਿਆਨ ਹੋਣਾ ਬਹੁਤ ਜ਼ਰੂਰੀ ਹੈ। ਇਹ ਸਾਰਿਆਂ ਨੂੰ ਬਰਾਬਰ ਦਾ ਹੱਕ ਦਿਵਾਉਣਾ ਚਾਹੁੰਦੇ ਸਨ। ਅੰਤ 1520 ਈ. ਨੂੰ ਅਕਾਲ ਚਲਾਣਾ ਕਰ ਗਏ।

21 ਫਰਵਰੀ ਬਾਵ ਅੱਜ ਦਾ ਦਿਨ ਅੰਤਰਰਾਸ਼ਟਰੀ ਮਾਤ ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਦਿਵਸ ਦੇ ਰੂਪ ਵਿੱਚ ਜਾਣਿਆ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ। ਬੋਲੀ ਸਾਡੀ ਪਹਿਚਾਣ ਤੇ ਵਿਅਕਤੀਤਵ ਨੂੰ ਪ੍ਰਮੁੱਖ ਰੱਖਣ ਵਿੱਚ ਅਹਿਮ ਭੂਮਿਕਾ ਅਦਾ ਕਰਦੀ ਹੈ। ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਬੋਲੀ ਨੂੰ ਆਪਣੇ ਮਾਣ-ਮੱਤੇ ਸੱਭਿਆਚਾਰ ਦੀ ਮੂੰਹ ਬੋਲਦੀ ਤਸਵੀਰ ਦੇ ਰੂਪ ਵਿੱਚ ਜਾਣਿਆ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ। ਅਜੋਕੇ ਸਮੇਂ ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਬੋਲੀ ਦਾ ਰੁਤਬਾ ਪਹਿਲਾਂ ਵਰਗਾ ਨਹੀਂ ਰਿਹਾ। ਕੋਈ ਸਮਾਂ ਸੀ ਜਦੋਂ ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਨਾਮ ਸੁਣ ਕੇ ਅਪਣਤ ਤੇ ਮੋਹ ਦਾ ਅਹਿਸਾਸ ਹੁੰਦਾ ਸੀ। ਪਰ ਹੁਣ ਅਸੀਂ ਖੁਦ ਇਸ ਵਿੱਚ ਹਿੰਦੀ ਤੇ ਅੰਗਰੇਜ਼ੀ ਦਾ ਰਲੇਵਾਂ ਕਰਕੇ ਆਪਣੀ ਮਾਂ ਬੋਲੀ ਦਾ ਰੂਪ ਵਿਗਾੜਣ ਤੇ ਲੱਗੇ ਹੋਏ ਹਾਂ। ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਨੂੰ ਕਿਸੇ ਵੀ ਤਰ੍ਹਾਂ ਜੀਵਤ ਰੱਖਣ ਦੀ ਲੋੜ ਹੈ। ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਬੋਲੀ ਕੋਈ ਕੰਮ ਜਾਂ ਮਜ਼ਬੂਤੀ ਦੀ ਮਲਕੀਅਤ ਨਹੀਂ। ਇਹ ਪੰਜਾਂ ਦਰਿਆਵਾਂ ਦੇ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਵਿੱਚ ਵਸਦੇ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਦੀ ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਹੈ। ਮਾਤ ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਮਨ ਨੂੰ ਸ਼ਾਂਤੀ ਪ੍ਰਦਾਨ ਕਰਦੀ ਹੈ, ਆਤਮਿਕ ਅਨੰਦ ਦਿੰਦੀ ਹੈ। ਸਾਨੂੰ ਇਸ ਦਾ ਗਿਆਨ ਸਭ ਤੋਂ ਵੱਧ ਜਰੂਰੀ ਹੈ।






