


# Malala Yousafzai

## The Girl Who Took a Bullet for Education



Every year on July 12th, world celebrates the birthday of Malala Yousafzai. She was born in Mingora, the Pakistan on 12th July 1997. In 2007 when Taliban group took over the city. They banned the education of girls. She raised her voice for their education. In 2009, Malala started a blog and wrote about life under Taliban rule in the pen named Gul Makai. She also wrote about her desire to go to school. For three years, she and her father advocated for the right for girls to attend school. She gained global attention when she survived an assassination attempt at age 15. She highlighted the need for worldwide access to women's education and called the world leaders to reform their policies therefore the UN promptly declared that the day is observed as " Malala Day "to honour the young activist. On September 1, 2008, when Yousafzai was 11 years old, her father took her to a local press club in Peshawar to protest the school closings, and she gave her first speech-"How Dare the Taliban Take Away My Basic Right to Education?" Her speech was publicized throughout Pakistan. At the age of 17, she received Noble peace prize and became the youngest recipient to receive it. In 2013, TIME Magazine declared Malala one of the world's most influential people. On July 12th 2013, Malala left everyone speechless as she spoke of "every child's right to education "in UN and received the United Nations Human Rights Prize and The Liberty Medal. To the present date, Malala has received over 40 awards and honours for her activism and relentless courage. In July 2015, with support from the Malala Fund, she opened a girls' school in Lebanon for refugees from the Syrian Civil War. Her life, before and after the attack she endured, was examined in the documentary He Named Me Malala (2015). The title referenced the fact that Yousafzai had been named for the Afghan heroine Malalai, or Malala, who purportedly led her people to victory against the British in the 1880 Battle of Maiwand.




